Children's Ministry

Sunday during services | K-grade 5

We have a thriving Sunday School with music, crafts, and lessons each week. Children can be dropped off in the Parish Hall just before service. Occasionally the class will be held outdoors at our playground, and sometimes they lead a worship song for the whole church. Parents pick up their children in time for Holy Communion.

SWAG (Saved with Amazing Grace)

Sunday during the 11am services | grade 5

As students head into the teen years, sometimes they forget who they are—a beloved child of God who has been saved by the amazing grace that Christ pours out from the cross.

Youth Group

Sundays 6:30-8pm grades 6-12

Our youth group meets in our youth-only building. After a time of worship led by the youth band & a meal, the teens separate into two groups for age-appropriate teaching and discussion.
