#### Summary

2023 income was good & expenses were exactly on budget, giving a healthy year-end surplus.

Capital reserves & help from the school funded major road repairs without any impact to the operational budget.

People have generously given an additional \$190,000 to the building fund already.

#### Summary

For 2024 we've reduced many expenses again to offset the effects of inflation.

But projected income is down a little, leading to a small deficit for the first time in quite a while.

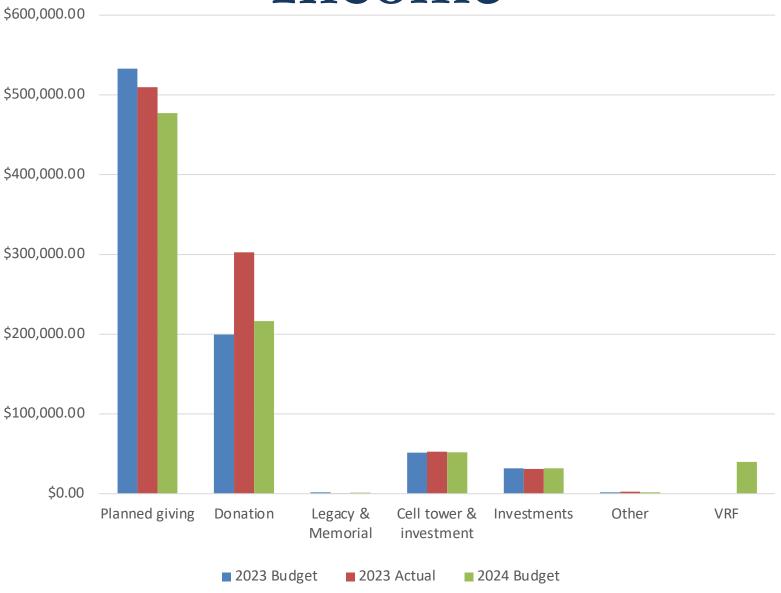

#### 2023 Additional Income

#### We also received:

- Rental income from SSA trailers \$100,000
- Proceeds from sale of plow truck \$18,409
- Building fund gifts \$190,894

We excluded these figures from the graphs to make year on year comparisons clearer. But it might explain some of the dip in projected income.

#### 2024 Income Notes

Many increased or submitted new intention cards.

We also expect donations to increase by at least \$17,000.

Investment income has increased.

But several have had to reduce their giving or not returned and intention of giving card.

Planned giving has dropped by \$55,800.

#### 2024 Income Notes

We are not budgeting for another year of trailer rental but it is likely.

As in 2023, we would invest that additional income rather than getting used to it for operational spending.

We cannot budget for legacy or memorial gifts, but they can make a huge difference.

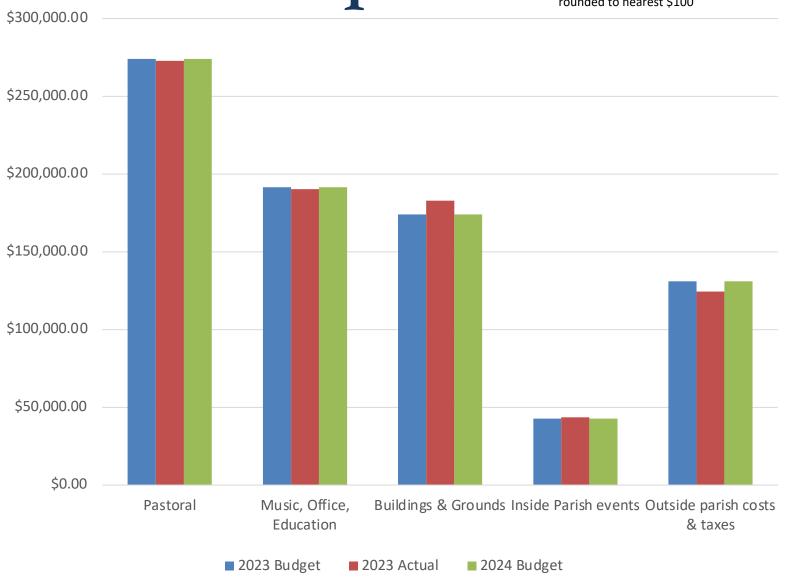

#### Expense Notes

In 2023, all categories were very close to budget (0.1% out from budget overall).

The 2024 budget is very similar to last year with large savings from:

- renegotiated utilities
- lower grounds costs with work contracted out

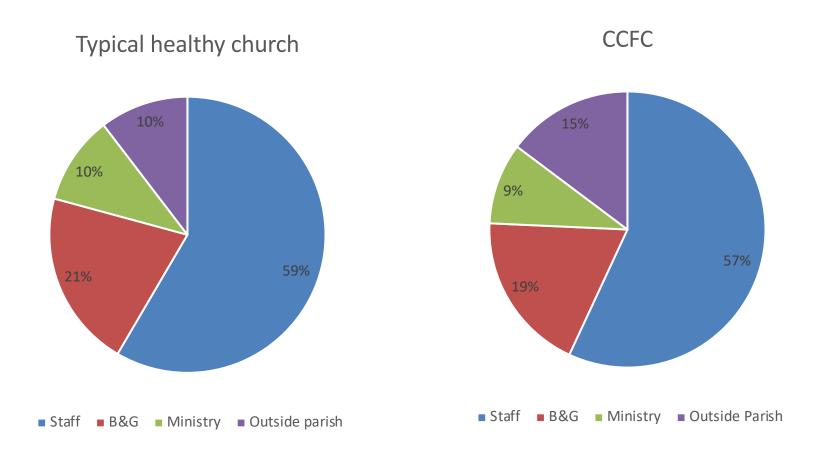
#### Expense Notes

Inflation increased our operating costs by \$30,000

But with significant savings in several categories, we are only increasing the total budget by \$7,000

Even adding a pastoral care ministry position for a whole year and a new Youth Ministry Assistant position and increasing mission.

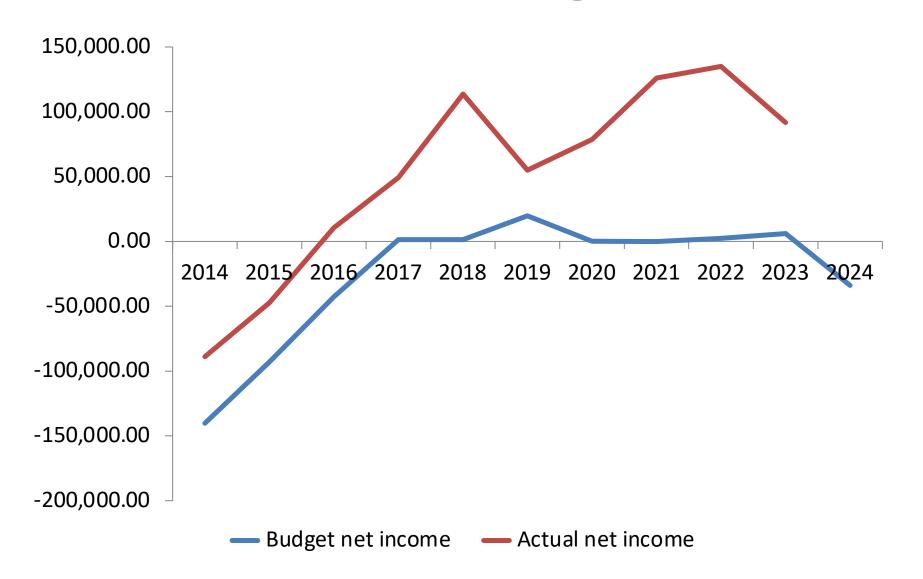

#### **Asset Notes**

Unrestricted assets increased by \$92,626.

Even though we spent \$179,341 on the road alone.

This is largely due to the \$90,000 surplus, \$100,000 income from the trailers, and market performance.

We also received an additional \$190,894 in building fund donations not included in these figures.

#### The sanctuary

- Inaccessible Communion rail too many steps
- Cluttered chancel, no room for choir
- Obscured views of the Lord's Table
- Lack of storage
- Bad light, sound, insulation, and décor
- Substantial organ repairs









### The Parish Hall

- Stage too high and too large
- Worn & damaged, floor, ceiling, lights, curtains, air vents, and speakers
- No light switch, thermostat, or A/C
- Poor sound, lights, and décor
- Squalid bathroom
- No Children's Ministry room
- Rotting walls and windows

\$20,000 to be received by 2026

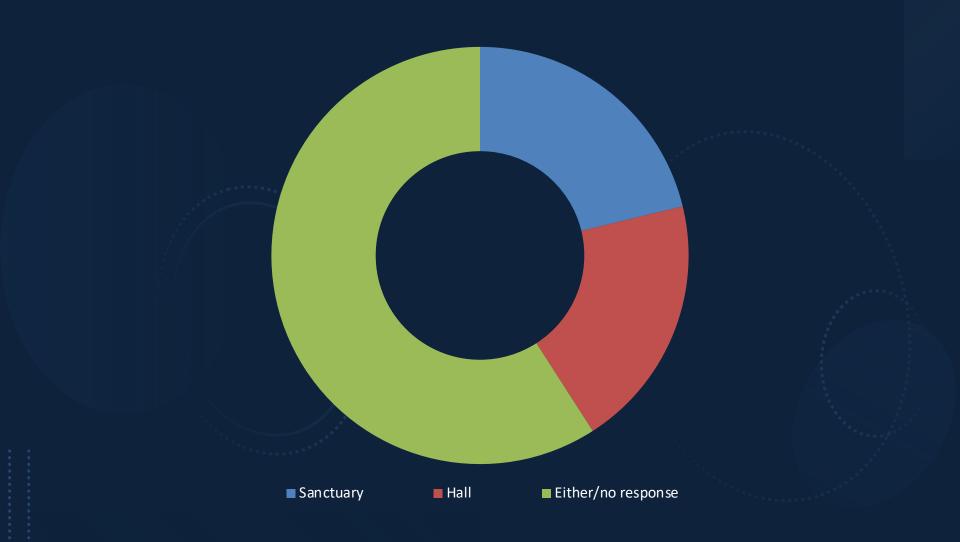

## Summary of last 10 years

- 50% attendance growth
- 100% income growth
- Average age lowered from 70's to 40's
- More commitment, connection, & contribution
  - especially in small groups & service team
- Surpluses used for extensive capital repairs
- Fixed almost everything except for two rooms
- Raised \$500,000 to renovate one more room

## Summary of last 10 years

- 2024 uses the VRF but that's what it's for
- Strong vestry,
  - who save for challenges &
  - balance conservative care of your money with kingdom call to advance the gospel
- Great staff team, heads of teams, & volunteers
