Hold onto your bread if you prefer to dip.*

*Parents of baptized children are welcome to decide whether you would like
your children to receive Holy Communion or a blessing.*

*To receive a blessing instead of communion,
simply keep your hands by your side or folded.*

If you require a gluten-free or alcohol-free cup, please ask the minister.

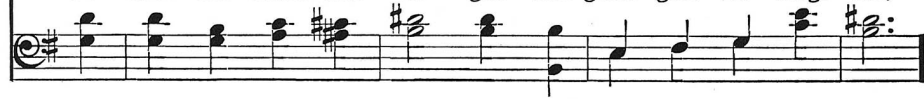
